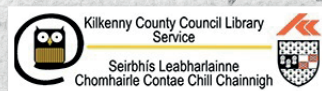
A New look for Graiguenamanagh library

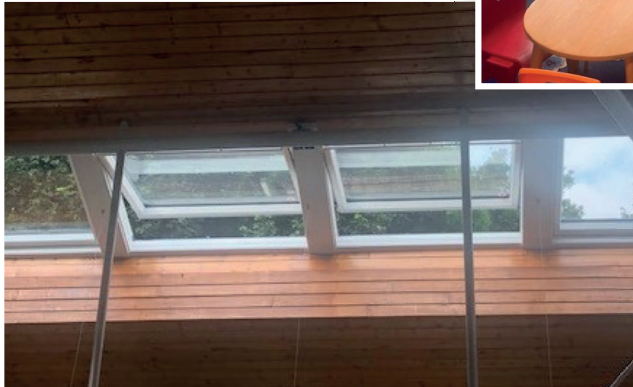


And we're back! We are delighted to be back in our newly refurbished library in Graiguenamanagh.
