If it is not just bound to physical books, make the pledge and read whatever you would like for the time pledged!



### eBooks and eAudiobooks

BorrowBox is so easy to use. All you have to do to register is choose your library from the menu, enter your library card number as the ID/Barcode, and your PIN as the password.

That's it, you're signed in and ready to browse and read! Or if you're too busy to sit down and read why not pop in your headphones and try an audiobook.

For Ireland Reads there are dedicated tabs full of new, in-demand, and recommended titles. Whether you Squeeze in a Read or Squeeze in a Listen, the choice is there for you. Sign up, sign in, and take a voyage with your next read.



The pledge to read can be made at [www.irelandreads.ie](http://www.irelandreads.ie) where you can also see how much time has been pledged by the Irish public so far and you can sign up for reading reminders. The website has a recommendations section, with more than 1500 recommendations for all interests and reading levels, selected by librarians from all around the country. You can get recommendations based on your interests, authors you like, and the time you have available to read. You can simply enter their favourite type of book and how long they would like to read each day and the website will offer the perfect book suggestion and work out how long it will take to complete - so you can set yourself a challenge if you're finding it hard to get back to reading, there will
